Eligibility criteria/Terms and conditions:

1. Applicants may be progressive fish farmers/Entrepreneurs/ State Government organizations/ federations/ corporations/ Cooperatives/ NGOs etc.
2. As the RAS is the super intensive aquaculture system, hence, the applicants should have own establishment of Farm/ garden activities etc. with its own manpower so that 24 hrs management of unit is ensured through available farm manpower.
3. Applicants must be financially sound and must provide evidence of availability of sufficient financial resources/credit linkage so that he can contribute the 50% of the beneficiary share of the project on its own to enable timely completion of the project.
4. Applicants must have sufficient suitable land (minimum one bigha) for establishment of the complete RAS unit. He/She shall provide documentary evidence of availability of requisite land viz., Recent Land Status Report and Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by Circle Officer. No funds shall be provided for procurement of lands.
5. The selected applicant will have to sign one Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the firm/institute/manufacturer of RAS to be recommended by the Director of Fisheries, Assam in presence of the undersigned.
6. Beneficiary will have to complete the work under the guidance & supervision of Director of Fisheries, Assam or his authorized representatives through the approved firm/institute/manufacturer of RAS unit and necessary consultancy fees will be paid to the said firm/institute/manufacturer of RAS unit accordingly as per the agreement.
7. Post construction operation, management and maintenance of the RAS shall be carried out in a satisfactory manner by the beneficiaries at their own costs.
8. The decision of the State level selection committee constituted as per guidelines

will be final and no claims whatsoever will be entertained.

The Director of Fisheries, Assam seeks Expression of Interest (Eoi) from eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS for empanelment of firms for setting up of 3 (Three) Nos. of RAS units in the State of Assam under CSS on Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries 2017-18. The Eoi will be received by the undersigned till 7th August, 2018. The details of the unit are as below:

Eligibility criteria/Terms & conditions:

1. The eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS must have proven track record and sufficient experience in setting up of Re-circulatory Aquaculture System (RAS) in the country / or elsewhere. They have to submit documentary proof in this regard.
2. The eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS must submit all details of experience in successful installation of RAS in the country/elsewhere
3. The Director of Fisheries, Assam will shortlist the eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS based on their experience and track record. The decision of the Director of Fisheries, Assam will be final.
4. The eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS must be financially sound and must provide evidence of availability of sufficient financial resources.
5. The eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS will complete work in all respect as per plan & estimate and technical specifications etc.
6. Beneficiary will pay the necessary consultancy fees to the selected firm/institute/manufacturer of RAS unit accordingly as per the tri-party agreement among District Fisheries Development Officer (DFDO) as the Representative of the Director of Fisheries, Assam; the beneficiary and the eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS.

7. The eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS must be responsible for demonstration of operation of the unit after successful installation and shall be responsible for maintenance of the unit satisfactory till the period of 1st crop/ or for a period of 12 (twelve) month, whichever is earlier. They shall provide training for operation of the entire project to the beneficiary for this period.
