- 4. The eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS must be financially sound and must provide evidence of availability of sufficient financial resources.
- 5. The eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS will complete work in all respect as per plan & estimate and technical specifications etc.
- 6. Beneficiary will pay the necessary consultancy fees to the selected firm/institute/manufacturer of RAS unit accordingly as per the tri-party agreement among District Fisheries Development Officer (DFDO) as the Representative of the Director of Fisheries, Assam; the beneficiary and the eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS.

The eligible firm/ Institutes/manufacturer of RAS must be responsible for demonstration of operation of the unit after successful installation and shall be responsible for maintenance of the unit satisfactory till the period of I<sup>st</sup> crop/ or for a period of 12 (twelve) month, whichever is earlier. They shall provide training for operation of the entire project to the beneficiary for this period.
